APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Application fee (non-refundable)

1. A participant may participate in more than one category, and in more than one discipline by submitting a separate Application Form together with the Application fee of that category/discipline.
2. A participant in the lower age group/category may participate in more than one higher age group / category, and in more than one discipline by submitting a separate Application Form together with the corresponding Application fee of that age group /category and discipline.
3. The following required documents must be sent to the following address:

- i. A duly completed Application Form(s) together with relevant documents.
- ii. Application fee[s] - non-refundable –
by bank draft/cheque, payable to Persatuan Chopin Malaysia
- iii. A photocopy of birth certificate, or NRIC, or International passport with a valid Malaysia visa and/or Malaysia PR status (for foreign students) to be attached.
- iv. A recommendation letter from the School / Teacher.
- v. 2 pieces recent photograph (passport size).

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES

All applications must reach **Persatuan Chopin Malaysia by/before 06 May 2017.**

Applications received after this date will not be entertained.

Early Birds Discount

Applications received before 15 April 2017 will be entitled to a RM50.00 discount off the Application fee.

Important notes to applicants:

- i. Incomplete Application Form[s] submitted and/or without the Application fee[s] and all required documents will not be processed.
- ii. Application Form[s] must be completed in clear writing or print. Intelligible form[s] will be rejected
- iii. The name of the participant in the Application Form[s] must be the same as the given name on the Birth certificate / NRIC / International passport.

- iv. Participants needing piano accompaniment are required to arrange their own accompanist.
- v. Results for each category/discipline will be announced no longer than 24 hours after the relevant category/discipline ends.
- vi. Prize winners will be announced at the end of each discipline.
- vii. The Honourable Juries will decide on the selection of the BEST candidates of each category and discipline to perform the GRAND FINALE (at a later date).
- viii. All winners selected by the Juries will be invited to perform at a Winners Gala Concert. The date and venue will be announced at a later date.
- ix. All Participants take note that you must be properly attired on Competition day.
- x. All participants of the Competition are reminded to look after their personal belongings/instruments. The Organizers will not be responsible nor indemnify for any loss and/or damage of the same.
