## FIRST PCM NATIONAL MUSIC AND DANCE COMPETITION, 20 MAY - 11 JUNE 2017

## **Competition procedure**

- 1. The **First PCM National Music and Dance Competition** is open to all Malaysians, and to foreign students residing in Malaysia with valid visa, and/or Malaysian PR status.
- 2. The First PCM National Music and Dance Competition will be in ONE (1) round ONLY.
- 3. The Age of qualification for all categories will be based as at 01 January 2017
- 4. All solo instrument /singing contestants must perform by memory, **EXCEPT** FOR Chamber Ensemble.
- 5. A change to the chosen repertoire pieces stated in the Application Form is NOT allowed.
- 6. Participants are advised to select pieces according to the performance duration stipulated in the **Discipline** and Category guidelines. The Juries reserve the right to stop any performance prior to, or during the Competition.
- 7. THREE (3) best performers will be nominated in each category.
- 8. All Juries' decisions are finale, and no appeal will be entertained.
- 9. Competitors are NOT permitted any interaction with members of the Jury. Any such attempt by any competitor will lead to disqualification from the Competition.
- 10. Competitors MUST submit 3 copies of their choice of music together with the Application Form, which will be used during the adjudication.
- 11. All copies of sheet music will be destroyed and not returned at the end of the Competition.
- 12. All competitors must organize their own piano accompanist, except for ballet /ballet ensemble.
- 13. Pre-recorded music on CD/DVD is NOT accepted as accompaniment, except for classical ballet.
- 14. All decisions concerning the Competition will remain the responsibility of the Organizers of the First PCM National Music and Dance Competition.
- 15. The Organizers reserve the right to cancel any category and/or discipline should there be fewer than six (6) applications in that category/discipline.
- 16. The Organizers reserve the right to make all final decisions in the event of any dispute.
- 17. Parents and Participants are NOT allowed any altercation with the Juries or Organizers. Disputes, if any, should be submitted in writing to the Organizers on the same day.
- 18. Participants' order of performance will be determined at a drawing session a week after the closing date to receive applications. The schedule will be posted on our official website www.chopinsociety.com.my
- 19. All participants will receive a 'Certificate of Participation'.
- 20. All performances are open to the public.
- 21. The top winners in each category and each discipline will receive cash prize, a trophy, and certificate.
